

## LEGACY ACADEMY PARENTAL COMMITMENT

The administration, faculty, and staff of Legacy Academy promise to assist parents in training their children by operating the school in accordance with its vision, mission, educational philosophy, and stated school policies.

In return, in keeping with the biblical principle that parents are primarily responsible for the education of their children and recognizing that the school and parents must walk together in agreement in order for success to be the result, the administration asks parents or guardians of Legacy Academy students to make the following acknowledgments and promises concerning their children:

- I understand and acknowledge my commitment to the philosophy of education at Legacy Academy.
- I understand and promise to abide by the policies of Legacy Academy as stated in the school handbook and other Legacy literature.
- I will keep apprised of my child's academic progress and behavior by appropriately communicating on a frequent and consistent basis with their teachers.
- I acknowledge my God-given responsibility to discipline my child. I understand that Biblical discipline involves internal attitudes and external actions. I want improper attitudes in my child properly confronted. When informed by the staff of behavioral infractions, I will properly discipline my child with the goal of ensuring that the infraction does not occur again. I wish to remain the child's primary disciplinary force and thus will fulfill my role in providing an atmosphere of discipline at home.
- I will be supportive of disciplinary action the school is required to take with my child.
- If I profess Christ as my Savior, I promise to regularly pray for the school's leadership, faculty, staff, and all students of Legacy Academy.
- I will provide my child an adequate place and time to study and complete homework.
- I promise to resolve disputes by dealing directly with the person or persons involved without criticizing them or the school. When the issue at hand is a sin issue the approach will be in accordance with the biblical instruction found in Matthew 18:15-17. I will maintain confidentiality of matters between teachers and administration, not sharing these with my child or any other individual who is not a part of the problem or solution. I will consult the school administration concerning any problem we are unable to resolve.
- I promise to take an active interest in all aspects of Legacy Academy, and as God leads us, and
  opportunities arise, to assume volunteer duties and responsibilities.
- I promise to attend parental meetings and parent-teacher conferences.
- I promise to pay all financial obligations to the school promptly. If unable to do so, I will notify the school
  immediately. I will be willing to bear my fair share of practical responsibilities in order to keep costs at a
  minimum.
- I will keep the school calendar a priority, planning ahead so conflicts can be avoided.
- Our family will volunteer a minimum of 10 hours per school year.

I understand that by not fulfilling my contractual obligation to Legacy Academy and to my child, this will result in my child being suspended or withdrawn from Legacy Academy.
